



EFFECTIVE HEALTH CARE DELIVERY AT THE GRASSROOTS: THE PRIMARY HEALTH CARE CHALLENGE

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
ABSTRACT: *A health care delivery system is the aggregate of institutions, organizations and persons who enter the health care system, who have responsibilities that include the promotion of health, prevention of illness, detection and treatment of disease, and rehabilitation. Effective health care (EHC) improves the quality of health care by providing the best available evidence on the outcomes, benefits and harms, and appropriateness of drugs, devices and health care services, and by helping health care professionals, patients, policymakers and health care systems. Health system also sometimes refers the organization of people, institutions, and resources that deliver health care services to meet the health needs of target populations. In some countries, health system planning is distributed among market participants.*


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GOAL FOR EFFECTIVES HEALTH CARE DELIVERY

WHAT EFFECTIVE HEALTH CARE DELIVERY IN THE GRASSROOTS SHOULD INVOLVE


In effective health care delivery, the nurse/midwife should adopt the following:

- Information update on health issuers


DOMAIN TO MEASURE EFFECTIVE HEALTH CARE DELIVERY IN THE GRASS ROOT


PRIMARY HEALTH CARE: THE NURSE COVERAGE




PHC CHALLENGES

- **Workplace violence:** Nurses and midwives are faced with the violent behaviors of patients/clients/community in the rural areas.
 - Problems between patients or the community may pose threat/danger to the midwife.
 - Violence and insecurity and in adequate nurse/midwife staffing level
- **Long working hours**
 - Know compensation, lack of respect from others, exposure to hazardous chemicals' exposure to diseases and inability to cost nursing care procedure
 - Lack of equipment, bad road, poor location of the health centers, inappropriate positioning, political will and education background.
